7-a-side (6-a-side UNDER 8s) - COMPETITION RULES

1. Each club must be affiliated to their local County F.A.
2. Each team may nominate a maximum of 10 players (9 for under 8s) aged under their chosen age group at midnight on 31 Aug of the current season.
3. A list, to include names and dates of birth of all players must be handed to the competition secretary at registration.
4. From this list a team of 7 players (6 for under 8s & 18s) shall be chosen to start each match.
5. Each team is allowed to use a maximum of 3 substitutes per match which can only take place at half time or in the event of an injury at the discretion of the referee.
6. Each team is to provide a suitable match ball (size 3 for under 8s, size 4 for under 9s – 15s, size 5 for under 16s – 18s).
7. In the event of a colour clash the second named team is to change strips.
8. If a team fails to turn up at the appointed time and place for a match they will be reported to the tournament secretary who will, unless given adequate reasons, award the match to the opposing team by a score of 2-0.
9. The duration of each match shall be two equal halves of 5 minutes with a half time interval of one minute.
10. The duration of the FINAL shall be two equal halves of 10 minutes with a half time interval of two minutes.
11. The tournament shall be played on a league basis. Final league positions shall be decided on points: 2 pts for a win, 1 pt for a draw. In the event of a points tie then goal difference will decide and if still tied then the side that scored the most goals will qualify. Where goal difference is equal in every respect then a penalty competition (consisting of 5 penalties) will decide followed by a sudden death penalty shootout if still required.
12. In the final, semi final and quarter finals the matches will be decided with 2 minutes each way of extra time if a match is drawn. If the score is still level at the end of extra time then a penalty competition will decide - in accordance with rule 11.
13. Each game shall commence and restart (after a goal) with a kick off from the centre of the playing field.
14. The Goalkeeper is not allowed to intentionally handle a back pass from one of their own players.
15. Goal kicks are to be taken off the ground anywhere in the defending teams' goal area.
16. Players are to retreat a minimum of 5 metres from all dead ball kicks.
17. The appointed match referee is the sole arbiter on points of law, any other matters in dispute will be referred to the competition secretary whose decision is final.
